EXODUS 24:12-18 - *Moses has received the Ten Commandments and other laws verbally from God on Mount Sinai. The people of Israel have agreed to obey them in exchange for God being their god and protecting them.*

PSALM 99 - *This is a hymn of praise to God as king.*

2 PETER 1:16-21 - *This letter is written as Peter's last testament. An eyewitness to Jesus' life, he leaves the Christian community with a sound foundation for faith based on experience. As Jesus appeared at his transfiguration in glory, so he will again when he comes a second time.*
