Your Plan This Week

- Use Monday to read Luke 7:34-35 and Luke 24:30-31 in their context. Reflect on their meaning and how to live them out in your life, church, and community. Notice that both of these passages are directed towards groups and their collective actions, not just individuals.
- Use Tuesday and Wednesday to memorize Luke 7:34-35 and use Thursday and Friday to memorize Luke 24:30-31. Use the weekend to practice both passages and reflect on them.
- Take 15 to 20 minutes each day to review the verses you've already memorized.
- Talk with someone else who is working through the KIMS about these verses and their meaning for our life together.

Luke 7:34-35 NRSV

34 the Son of Man has come eating and drinking, and you say, "Look, a glutton and a drunkard, a friend of tax-collectors and sinners!" 35 Nevertheless, wisdom is vindicated by all her children.'

Luke 24:30-31

30 When he was at the table with them, he took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them. 31 Then their eyes were opened, and they recognized him; and he vanished from their sight.
