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## WEEK 11 PLAN

**Topic:** Spirit-led Listening    **Subtopic:** Seek Guidance and Direction

**Verses:** Psalm 25:4-5 and Proverbs 2:6-9

## Your Plan This Week

- Use Monday to read **Psalm 25:4-5** and **Proverbs 2:6-9** in their context. Reflect on their meaning and how to live them out in your life, church, and community. Notice that both of these passages are directed towards groups and their collective actions, not just individuals.
- Use Tuesday and Wednesday to memorize **Psalm 25:4-5** and use Thursday and Friday to memorize **Proverbs 2:6-9**. Use the weekend to practice both passages and reflect on them.
- Take 15 to 20 minutes each day to review the verses you've already memorized.
- Talk with someone else who is working through the KIMS about these verses and their meaning for our life together.

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## **Psalm 25:4-5 NRSV**

**4 Make me to know your ways, O Lord; teach me your paths. 5 Lead me in your truth, and teach me, for you are the God of my salvation; for you I wait all day long.**

## **Proverbs 2:6-9 NRSV**

**6 For the Lord gives wisdom; from his mouth come knowledge and understanding; 7 he stores up sound wisdom for the upright; he is a shield to those who walk blamelessly, 8 guarding the paths of justice and preserving the way of his faithful ones. 9 Then you will understand righteousness and justice and equity, every good path;**
